8th Conference of Indian Meat Science Association (IMSACON-VIII)



The Department of Livestock Products Technology, Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, WBUAFS, Kolkata organized International Symposium Conference and the 8th of Indian Meat Science (IMSACON-VIII) Association on "Technological innovations in muscle food processing for nutritional security, quality and safety" during November 22-24, 2018. The conference provided a platform for interaction and linkage amongst the scientists, academicians, processors and entrepreneurs from different parts of India and from Australia, Bangladesh and few other countries. They shared their opinion and experience on the present national scenario and offered suggestions for further accelerated growth in the muscle food industry. The conference stressed on strategies with multispectral approach for enhancing state-of-art technologies and innovations for processing of muscle food from livestock, poultry and fish. Besides, the conference proposed some tangible hints to the policy makers for creation of required infrastructure and enabling environment to boost muscle food industry in global perspectives. Indian Meat Science Association proposed a Gold Medal in the name of IMSACON-8 for the student of Livestock Products Technology ranking first in the Master's Degree programme. Same has been approved in the 100th Executive Council Meeting of the University for implementation from ensuing year.

The KVK celebrated World Soil Day on 5th December, 2018 which was inaugurated by Md. Badaruddoza Khan, Hon'ble Member of Parliament. On the occasion, the Programme Coordinator spoke about soil health card & world soil day. From October to December, 2018, the KVK organized training programmes and distributed inputs under Krishi Kalyan Abhiyan, Phase-II. The KVK observed World Food Day on 16th October, 2018, Mahila Kisan Diwas on 15th October, 2018, District Kisan Mela from 20th to 21st February, 2019, and Rabi Sammelan on 22nd February, 2019. Under Swachhata Pakhwada-2018, the KVK organized activities like cleaning of street, drain and back alleys, development of compost pits; and arranged debates, discussion and awareness camps. Also took up "Safai Abhiyan" in KVK & surrounding villages under Swachhata Hi Seva initiative.

The KVK produced and sold true to the types seed of EFY var. Kovur, termaric var. Suranjana, grafted seedling of mango var. Himsagar, Langra, Amrapalli, Mallika, Laxman Bhog etc. The KVK cultivated green fodder (oats, maize and cow pea) and sold to livestock farmers. To boost the productivity of oilseed, the KVK involved progressive farmers in technology demonstration through introduction of improve variety, bio-fertilizer and micro nutrient. 18th SAC Meeting was held on 12th February, 2019 to review the progress of mandated activities of the year 2018-2019 and to finalize the Action plan for 2019-2020. Prof. P Biswas, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor chaired the meeting. Prof. A. Goswami, Director of Research, Extension & Farms, WBUAFS addressed the meeting.

Training and Exposure visit: To create awareness among the Input dealers under the programme of Diploma in Agricultural Extension Services for Input Dealers (DAESI), the KVK conducted training-cum-exposure visits for the participants of Jalpaiguri, Alipurduar, Coochbehar, Uttar Dinajpur & Malda districts. Under the programme of Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA), the KVK organized training-



cum-exposure visits for the participants of Jalpaiguri, Alipurduar, Coochbehar, Kalimpong, Uttar Dinajpur, Malda and Murshidabad to create awareness on region-specific eco-friendly technologies. Similar activities were conducted under Integrated Watershed Management Programmee (IWMP) for the members of Watershed clusters from Jalpaiguri, Alipurduar and Coochbehar districts.

The programme was inaugurated by Hon'ble MLA of Dhupguri, Mrs Mitali Roy. World Environment Day was celebrated on 5th June, 2018 in the presence District Magistrate of Jalpaiguri. World Veterinary Day was celebrated on 28th April, 2018 at Basilar Danga, Maynaguri in collaboration with Bagjan Progotishil FPO. National Fish Farmer's Day was celebrated 10th July, 2018 in presence of district officials from Department of Fishery and Agriculture. The programme was covered by Doordarshan Kendra, Jalpaiguri.

Field Experience Training (FET): The 21 day field experience training was executed from 19th February to 11th March, 2019 with village survey, seminar & interaction, institutional seminar along with other curriculum for skill and knowledge development in agriculture and allied sector.

Jalpaiguri KVK Mobile App was launched during the Celebration of University Foundation Day. This is an educational App providing all required information to farming community & extension workers. The App is available on Google Play Store for free.

Technology Week-cum-District Kisan Mela was organized at KVK Campus during 18th - 20th February, 2019 for Jalpaiguri district and during 21st-22nd February, 2019 at Dalimpur, Falakata for

Alipurduar district. Shri Ananta Deb Adhikary, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Maynaguri inaugurated the Jalpaiguri Kisan Mela.

North 24 Parganas Krishi Vignan Kendra

In the year 2018-19, the KVK conducted 13 nos. of On Farm Trial (OFT) covering 78 farmers, 19 nos. of Front Line Demonstration (FLD) covering 715 farmers, 112 nos. of training helping 2790 farmers and 439 nos. of different extension activities covering 3749 nos. of beneficiaries in North 24 Parganas District. The farm sector of the KVK produced total 38.99 q seed and 25000 different planting materials for distribution to famers. KVK also cultivated rice varieties like GS1, Shatabdi (IET 4786), Gobindavog, Khitish etc.; sesamum (Rama), tuber crops (Bidhan Kusum), Grams (Prakash), Mustard (B54) in its instructional farm. Besides, sale of livestock and fish fingerling generated revenue of Rs. 3.013 lakh for the year. Under CFLD of Pulse and Oil seeds programme, Blackgram (Sulata), Lentil (Moitree WBL77) and Mustard (YSH0401) were successfully demonstrated on cluster basis at different blocks of district. The mobile advisory service (KMAS) delivered information on weather and other agriculture related events to farmers. Soil Health Cards were distributed regularly among the farmers after testing the soil samples in its own laboratory. Farmers were encouraged to take up new HYV of black gram, to rear Vanaraja birds in backyard poultry, to culture improved fish variety of Jayanti Rohu and Chital farming with Tilapia for better returns.



District Kisan Mela and Technology Week was observed in presence of Hon'ble MP, Mrs Mamata Thakur, Prof. P. Biswas, Hon'ble VC, WBUAFS and Mr. Surajit Biswas, Hon'ble MLA in Gaighata Block in which around 800 farmers attended. KVK organised the extension programme on 'Income generation through agriculture by women' with the school going *Kanyashrees* of local school. The activities under externally funded projects included demonstration by NFDB, STR (ATMA funded), DAESI (SAMETI guided and self financed), FOCT (CDB funded) and ASCI (NSCI funded). KVK facilitated quality fish seed distribution by developing the marketing network of WBADMIP–KVK-Farmers. With the help of KVK and District Agriculture office, a mini oil-mill was established through Farmers' club.
