Candidates with hands-on experience in microbiology, molecular biology, genomics, zoonotic pathogen surveillance, field sample collection or laboratory diagnostics will be preferred.

Emoluments: ₹28,000/- per month + HRA as admissible (consolidated).

Tenure of appointment: Initially for one year, extendable up to the duration of the project based on performance and project requirements, as per ICMR guidelines. The post is purely temporary and coterminous with the tenure of the project and the appointments; therefore, does not confer any right/claim implicit or explicit for regularization or absorption against any University post.


Eligible candidates may appear for the interview with five copies of their CV and a set of attested copies of all certificates and testimonials, along with originals on the date and time mentioned.
